H is for Handshake

On 17 July 1975 the Apollo and Soyuz spacecrafts docked with each other, somewhere over West Germany. **A historic handshake** took place between Astronaut Thomas P. Stafford and Cosmonaut Aleksei A. Leonov, that ended the "space race", a race that had started with the Soviet Union putting the first artificial satellite into space and ended with "one giant leap for mankind" on the surface of the Moon for American Neil Armstrong.
